c.	Forensic Audit	OPEN – Auditor requesting guidance on whether to continue with the audit and indicated

d.	Sports Park parking lot paving	OPEN – Issue moved for discussion during an executive session meeting for discussion and
		resolution.
e.	Dog Park	OPEN – Voted on during the executive session - contract awarded (\$11,641.96) to
		Delagarza to install fencing around the entire dog park.

#### V. Executive Session Results

• Executive session June 29, 2017-The Board approved the dog fence contract to Delagarza (see above), contract for the ditches (\$1800.00) and baseball dugouts (\$5500.00) to Alamo. Finally, the board approved sending 22 delinquent accounts to legal and to waive one delinquent account. The board discussed a trip to Austin to lobby for the right to vote on the annexation of HOAs outside the 1604 loop by the city of San Antonio.

### VI. New business

- a. Erasers along main roads/erosion concerns was discussed. Wildflower mixture was suggested as a possible ground cover by a Board member. Moved to unfinished business as an open item.
- b. Fences and kickboards was discussed. The Board noted that there was a lot of visible damage to fencing. Moved to open business for action.
- c. Fees and policy for resale certificates was discussed. A board member noted that the HOA's budget can afford to eliminate the fees collected from the sale of resale certificates. A motion was made, seconded and approved by the three directors present to eliminate the resale certificate fee.
- d. Goodwill opportunities. Board approved a gun familiarization class being held in the community center. The board also approved the use of the HOA's baseball fields for practice by local school league teams.
- e. Food trucks –Brisket Boys BBQ was voted on to be the preferred vendor for events.
