Thanks to this improvement in communication, we have seen increased patrols, and we have also worked closely with the Bexar County SCORE unit in breaking up some very large homeless camps within our area, and we now have a direct contact to report recordings of gun shots heard within the community, so they can continue to investigate and apprehend those committing these crimes. The Sheriff's Office Community Outreach Program brought out their mounted patrols, ATVs, and drove through the area targeting areas of concern and also enlisted the help of Environmental Services in cleaning up dumped items & non-working vehicles throughout the community. I personally invited Sheriff Salazar and our County Commissioner to come to a Safety Townhall Meeting held last Spring to hear concerns directly from our residents. They gave us some insight into the crime in our area and many areas we could improve upon as a community and in our own homes.

We have increased communication through social media and are recording Board meetings and publishing them on You Tube for residents to listen to at their convenience. This has aligned with our commitment of full transparency.

As you can see I have been very connected to our community in a variety of ways over the last 22 years. This is the best community in San Antonio, and I knew as soon as my husband and I moved back to San Antonio, this was exactly where I wanted to raise our family!

Please give me your vote again this April and allow me to continue to serve this wonderful community. I promise to continue to be open, honest, and to hear what the residents have to say, while continuing my commitment to community safety, communication, and beautification!
